#### Health and Safety Legislation

The Statute law includes the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 (HSWA) which is an enabling Act of Parliament along with a number of Statutory instruments which take the form of regulations such as:

1. The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999
2. The Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2004
3. The Electricity at Work Regulations 1989.
4. The Health and Safety (Display Screen Equipment) Regulations 1992
5. The Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992
6. The Fire Precautions (work place) Regulations 1999.
