About the Exercise Programme

Patients diagnosed with cancer at Salisbury Hospital can access Prehabilitation **before** treatment or surgery, and Rehabilitation **during and after** their hospital care.

Our team of Cancer Specialist Exercise Instructors and Physiotherapists will meet you at the Odstock Health and Fitness Centre at the hospital and prescribe you an exercise programme tailored to your preference and needs.

You may be offered a free 12-sessions pass for a Leisure Centre^{*} of your choice with a six-month expiry time. After 12 sessions, if you choose to continue attending the Leisure Centre, you will not be charged a joining fee and you can choose the membership suitable for you.

Activities Available

Your Exercise Instructor or Physiotherapist will advise which activities are best suited for you. The following are included in your 12-session pass:

Gym: Leisure Centre gym induction is included in your free membership

Swimming: Your pass enables you to swim at the Leisure Centre and undertake aqua classes if they are on offer.

Classes: Most Leisure Centres have a range of classes which may include aerobic, strength and conditioning classes and Yoga/Pilates. All qualifying Leisure Centres have classes except Trowbridge Sports Centre. Bradford on Avon Pool and Westbury Pool only offer aqua classes.

Your Exercise Instructor or Physiotherapist will meet you on a regular basis to monitor your progress, adjust your exercise programme and discuss any issues or concerns that you may have.
